Your Coordinator is registered with the police and WILL NOT disclose your contact details to anyone.

Ways you can help yourself and others

Be Vigilant – report anything suspicious to either your co-ordinator (by phone) or neighbourhood police team

on 101

Record unfamiliar vehicle registration numbers.

Leave a light/radio on when you go out.

Tell your neighbours/ co-ordinator when you are going away.

Park on a neighbour's drive if they are away (with their consent).
